Greetings U3A Nelson Members

At our meeting on 14 December I spoke of the process to be followed to get into study groups for the coming year. This is repeated below.

Each study group topic is labelled on the accompanying Study Group Programme according to one of four categories

- 1. **Continuing** means this study group will continue in 2012. [N.B. Some continuing groups are full others have some space for additional members. This is noted on the programme.]
- 2. **Repeat** means that a popular study group is to be offered again.
- 3. **New** means that a new study group will start offering a new topic.
- 4. **Possible** is a topic that has been suggested as likely to be of interest to some U3A members. If a possible topic receives four or more registrations the committee will set up a meeting with those members for the purpose of organising a new group.

To register for membership of a study group for 2012

If you are a member of a continuing study group and wish to continue in that group during 2012 all you need to do is tell the study group convener that you want to continue *and* complete your 2012 U3A Membership Form.

For a spare place in a continuing group or a place in a new, repeat or possible group you must fill in a Study Group Registration Form and complete your 2012 U3A Membership Form.

A copy of the 2012 U3A Membership Form and the Study Group Registration Form along with the 2012 Study Group Programme is sent to you with this newsletter. Additional copies are available on our website. To be considered for start up in

February forms should be posted in time to reach our post box before 31 January 2012.
